

Makom Kadosh, Sacred Space.


WOW!

In Hebrew, in addition to **בֵּית כְּנֶסֶת**, synagogue, there is also the phrase, **מָקוֹם קָבִיעַ**, from *Sefer Beresheet* when *Avraham* created a prayer space to pray to God. **מָקוֹם קָבִיעַ** refers to a holy place that is separate and unique. As we enter this **מָקוֹם קָבִיעַ** we join our community to pray together.






