
Hear! Listen! Israel: God is our God, God is One!

Praise God's name Whose honor and presence is with us now and forever.

It is sometimes very hard to describe "love." We can describe what we love or how we show love, but the feeling itself is often an indescribable emotion. When the Shema challenges us to love God, the text does not define what this love is. Instead the Shema gives us a road map to form this type of powerful relationship in our lives.

What do you think it means to love God? You should love God With all of your thoughts With all of your feelings And with all of your actions.

And these words that I command you today, must always be in your heart. Instruct these commandments to your children and speak of them when you are sitting at home, when you are traveling on a path, when you go to sleep, and when you wake up. Attach a symbol of your partnership with God on your arm and between your eyes and write this reminder on the doorposts of your houses and on your gates.

MOURNER'S KADDISH
